ALBERT BICHOT

Corton Clos des Maréchaudes Domaine du Pavillon 2022

96 points | \$373 | 117 cases imported | Red



Well-marked by new oak, this red also features flavors of cherry, blackberry, black currant, violet, sandalwood and vanilla. An iron component seeps in as this evolves across the palate, its suppleness offset by a firm line of tannins. In the end, this is juicy, with fruit and oak spice notes. Best from 2028 through 2047. From France.—B.S.
