In addition to the various in-person and Zoom tastings I attended here in Los Angeles, I traveled to Paso Robles to delve into the wineries of the CAB Collective. I ventured to Oregon to visit the Umpqua Valley, Tualatin Valley, and Willamette Valley for wine. While on the East Coast, I visited Finger Lakes and Laurel Highlands, Pennsylvania. My journeys, as always, took me to the Santa Barbara Wine Country to discover new wineries since the area is my favorite place within two hours of my home. I ended my year with a trip to Temecula.

This year, my list is more heavily weighted in white wine. Maybe the regions I visited or the current white wine vintages left a more lasting impression.
